Substitution of words	<b>1.</b> In Section 3, subsection (3) of the principal Act, the following words shall be substituted:—	
Time limit for approval of detention order	The words "twelve days" shall be substituted by the words "fifteen days".	
Substitution of words	<b>2.</b> In Section 3, subsection (4) of the principal Act, the following words shall be substituted:—	
Time limit for Reporting detention to Central Government	The words "seven days" shall be substituted by the words "fifteen days".	
Avoiding overlapping powers	<b>3.</b> In Section 8, after sub-section(2), of the principal Act, the following shall be inserted;	
	Section 8(3): "Representation, if any, either from the detainee or from any person including a relative, a friend or an advocate on behalf of the detainee may be preferred to the Central Government only after the State Government confirms the said detention order under Section 12 (1)."	
Substitution of words	<b>4.</b> In Section 13, sub-section (1) of the principal Act, the following words shall be substituted:—	
Maximum period of detention	The words "six months" shall be substituted by the words "twelve months".	
Insertion of words	5. In Section 14 of the principal Act, the following words shall be inserted after the words "General Clauses Act, 1897 (10 of 1897)",	
Overriding powers to Central Government for revocation of detention order, if satisfied	"and notwithstanding anything contained in Section 8, sub-section (3) of the principal Act,"
