Regional Reference Standards Laboratory, Faridabad

Regional Reference Standards Laboratory at Faridabad, Haryana has been established by the Central Government to cater to the needs of State Government and industries of northern region of the country in respect of the Legal Metrology. The States covered are Uttar Pradesh, Uttrakhand, Himachal Pradesh, J&K, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi & UT Chandigarh.

Main functions of the laboratory are,

- Verification of legal standards of State Governments,
- ii. Model Approval Testing of the weighing and measuring instruments covered under the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and Rules made there under and
- iii. On request calibration of instruments for the industries.
- 2. The laboratory has been accredited under **National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL)** in April 2007 in Mass Metrology and Calibration of the balances. RRSL, Faridabad is only laboratory among other RRSLs accredited by the NABL with accreditation certificate no. C 0475 which valid up to 12.04.2015.
- 3. Apart from above, Fluid Control Research Institute (FCRI), Palghat has developed Flow Measurement facility at RRSL, Faridabad.
- 4. Besides, laboratory is also engaged in organizing training/seminars for the State Govts. officials in the field of Legal Metrology and related topics.
